IV. Reports from Chairs

a. HS Choral - Russ Vallier

Russ has tentatively lined up Pam Bushouse as the choral clinician for the December Honor Group event.

b. HS Band – Willey Abati

No clinician booked yet. Students can be in both district honor band and district honor jazz band

c. HS Jazz - Larry Lillard

Wayne Goins of KSU will be the Jazz Clinician. Robert Kehle, PSU Jazz Director, has confirmed that Thursday Dec. 3 will be the date of the PSU Jazz concert, with the SE KMEA District Jazz Band on the same program. The event will be all day. Larry has asked that Wayne be compensated more than the designated 275.00

d. HS/MS Orchestra – Faye Millen takes over for Rebecca Grotts. Faye submitted a written report. There will be paper auditions for the December Honor Orchestra. There will not be a November Orchestra activity. Clinician for December is not yet booked. Faye brought up the need for a State String Orchestra for 1-4A schools. Faye expressed concern about the current state of the Pittsburg Middle School Orchestra program and the Parsons Orchestra Program in terms of local support for their continued existence. Faye noted that there will be a February 2010 Middle School Mass Orchestra event – date and place to be determined.

#### e. MS Choral – Pam McDaniel

Pam submitted a written report. For the Jan. 16 MS Honor Choir event, each school may send 6 singers from grades 7 and 8 in the following voicings: 2 sopranos, 2 altos, and 2 baritones. Deadline for registration for this event is November 13, 2009. Rosie Sweaney will be the accompanist. Clinician is not yet booked. Darla Strecker has declined, and other possibilities are Mark Bartel and Scott Hay. Pam asked that there be more risers this year if there are 180 students. Pam also requested accommodations for directors who get a new class for second semester. Directors could reserve 6 spots and submit names by January 8.

## f. MS Band – Jeff Russell –

Jeff has tentatively booked Ed Bartley as the January 16 clinician for MS Band. There was a long discussion regarding ways to improve the quality of the band. Larry had some suggestions for the program regarding literature (Dark Adventure by Ralph Ford) and suggested that all directors receive a full score and/or complete set of parts to facilitate learning of the music in the regular rehearsal setting, thereby enabling each honor band student to be better prepared.

# h. Advocacy - John Womeldorff

- There was a consensus to allow the use of adult professional instrumentalists at KSHSAA large group for choirs.
- There was a consensus that freshmen should be allowed to audition for and perform at the State KMEA ISW.
